Advance In Person <b>*(AIP)</b>	3718	All absentee by mail applications are processed by verifying their identifying information in the Gergia Voter Registration System (GARViS and checking their signatures. Once approved, data is recorded on application and ballots are pulled and mailed to voters. If a voters information cannot be verified an application is rejected or CURED and that voters must be mailed a etter regarding their staus. Once a ballot is received it is compared to the information on file in GARViS and is Accepted or Rejected if information is matched.
