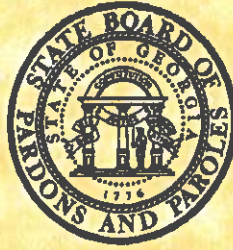


STATE BOARD OF PARDONS AND PAROLES



ORDER SUSPENDING THE EXECUTION OF SENTENCE OF DEATH

WHEREAS, upon the 30th day of September, 2007, a sentence of death was imposed on the defendant in the case of The State of Georgia v. Stacey Ian Humphreys, 374523, Indictment Number 04-9-0673 before the Superior Court of Cobb County; and,

WHEREAS, an order of the Superior Court of Cobb County, dated the 1st day of December, 2025, directs that Stacey Ian Humphreys shall be executed by the Department of Corrections during a certain period of time commencing at noon on the 17th day of December, 2025, and ending at noon on the 24th day of December, 2025; and,


WHEREAS, the State Board of Pardons and Paroles has received, on behalf of Stacey Ian Humphreys, a clemency application requesting that the Board exercise its authority to commute his sentence of death; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Article IV, Section II, Paragraph II (a) and (d) of the Constitution of the State of Georgia and O.C.G.A. Section 42-9-20, the Chair or any other member designated by the Board may suspend the execution of a sentence of death;

NOW, THEREFORE, on behalf of the Members of the State Board of Pardons and Paroles, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the execution of the sentence of death in this case be and hereby is **SUSPENDED**.
