




Vehicle 1 was driven to a controlled rest partially off of the north side of the roadway.

DIAGRAM OF ACCIDENT




Diagram indicates area of final rest only.




DIAGRAM OF ACCIDENT



Investigative Summary

SCRTF-011-16

On Monday, April 11, 2016 at approximately 7:43 a.m., the Toombs County 911 Center was notified of a motor vehicle collision on State Route 292 in Vidalia. The collision involved a passenger car and a bicyclist. The Vidalia Police Department arrived on scene and requested their dispatch contact the Georgia State Patrol. At approximately 8:08 a.m. the Georgia State Patrol's Troop F Communication Center was informed of the collision. The communications center dispatched Cpl. James Metts #809 of Post 18 Reidsville. He arrived on scene at approximately 8:21 a.m. and made contact with Vidalia P.D. Sgt. A. Rollins. Sgt. Rollins explained the circumstances of the collision. The collision involved a silver 2010 Lincoln MKZ, driven by Michael Blake Tillery and a green Fuji bicycle ridden by Bunji Mark Takaya.

At approximately 8:36 a.m., Doctor Ian Christopher Munger pronounced Mr. Bunji Mark Takaya deceased at the Meadows Regional Medical Center emergency room in Vidalia. Mr. Takaya was the bicyclist struck on State Route 292.

At approximately 8:36 a.m., Cpl. Metts contacted TFC3 Charles Hardy #700, with the Georgia State Patrol's Troop F Specialized Collision Reconstruction Team. Cpl. Metts explained the circumstances of the collision to TFC3 Hardy and requested SCRTF's assistance with the collision investigation. TFC3 Hardy arrived at the collision scene at approximately 9:27 a.m. TFC3 Michael Jackson #949 also arrived on scene at approximately 9:33 a.m. to assist.

At approximately 9:38 a.m., Michael Blake Tillery agreed to and signed a blood and urine sample consent form.

TFC3 Jackson started taking photos of the collision scene and evidence. TFC3 Hardy made contact with Cpl. Metts. Cpl. Metts explained the circumstances and advised TFC3 Hardy that a witness by the name of Brandie Renell Kirkland was still on scene. TFC3 Hardy contacted Ms. Kirkland at approximately 10:14 a.m. and requested an audio recorded interview. Ms. Kirkland stated she would give an interview. Ms. Kirkland stated she was going to work and was traveling behind a burgundy Chevy Tahoe. She observed the Tahoe brake and travel into the oncoming traffic lane. She stated she heard a loud noise just before the Tahoe swerved. As the Tahoe moved over she stated she observed the bicyclist slung off onto the shoulder. She stated she pulled onto the shoulder and observed the driver of the vehicle in front of the Tahoe running back to the bicyclist. Ms. Kirkland then stated she called Toombs County 911. While talking with 911 she observed a gentleman checking the bicyclist pulse. She stated she never saw the Tahoe stop. TFC3 Hardy asked Ms. Kirkland if the driver of the silver car that hit the bicyclist moved after he stopped to render aid. Ms. Kirkland stated he never moved the car after he stopped. TFC3 Hardy asked Ms. Kirkland about

the weather conditions at the time of the collision. Ms. Kirkland stated it was daylight, clear skies, and the sun was to their backs traveling on State Route 292 westbound. After the interview was complete Ms. Kirkland checked her phone to see the approximate time she contacted the Toombs County 911 Center. The time displayed on the phone recent call list was 7:43 a.m.

At approximately 10:25 a.m., Michael Blake Tillery's blood was drawn by Assistant Lab Director Regina G. Williams. Ms. Williams used the Georgia Bureau of Investigation blood alcohol and toxicology kit provided by Cpl. Metts at Meadows Regional Medical Center. Cpl. Metts packaged and sealed the blood kit to be transported to the Georgia Bureau of Investigation Crime Lab.

While still on scene TFC3 Hardy attempted to image the "Restraint Control Module" (RCM) from the 2010 Lincoln MKZ. In recent years breakthrough technology has been created to image data information stored within certain model vehicles. The Crash Data Retrieval System or (CDRS) is manufactured, and produced by Bosch Corporation. Collision or crash information that is stored in the Restraint Control Module (RCM) can be extracted, and read using CDRS. By linking the CDRS directly to the vehicle's Diagnostic Link Connector (DLC) the investigator can image pre-crash and post-crash information. Important crash information such as vehicle speeds five (5) seconds prior to and after impact, percentage of throttle used, engine rpm, delta V (change in velocity graph), brake switch status, and seat belt status can be obtained using the CDRS. During the vehicle image TFC3 Hardy accessed the data by connecting to the DLC. The image was successful, and the Restraint Control Module did not record a "deployment event" nor a "non-deployment event". A copy of the image is included in this case file.

After marking and photographing the scene, TFC3 Hardy traveled to the Toombs County District Attorney's office. At the D.A.'s office TFC3 Hardy contacted Chief Investigator Allen W. McCall. TFC3 Hardy explained the case and the circumstances to Mr. McCall. Mr. McCall assisted in writing a preservation letter to Verizon Wireless for Michael Blake Tillery's phone records from the time of the collision.

While still in Vidalia, TFC3 Hardy travelled to the local Ford dealership to make contact with Matthew Scott Russell. Mr. Russell was identified as a possible witness to the collision. TFC3 Hardy made contact with Mr. Russell and requested an audio recorded interview. Mr. Russell stated he was approaching the collision scene from the west traveling east. Mr. Russell stated he observed something go into the air and then saw two vehicles pull onto the shoulder. He stated he saw debris and assumed someone had been rear ended. He stated he realized as he was passing that there was damage to a white MKZ Lincoln and a man lying on the shoulder near a bicycle. He stated he turned around at the house near the scene and parked his vehicle partially in the road to protect the individuals on the scene. Mr. Russell stated he walked up to the scene and observed the driver that hit the bicyclist and a white female standing near the scene on her phone. He also stated there was another white male on his knees checking the bicyclist's pulse. He stated the man checked for a pulse in several

locations and didn't find a pulse. He stated the gentleman that hit the bicyclist was kneeling near the victim and he kept saying he didn't know how this happened, he was following the white lines. Mr. Russell stated he said this several times and then stood up and walked off very briskly in the direction of his vehicle. He stated one of the women on scene asked if he thought the driver was leaving the scene. Mr. Russell stated he didn't think so, because of all the damage to the front of the vehicle. He stated the driver attempted to open the passenger door of the car several times, but the door wouldn't open. He stated the driver then went to the driver's side and sat down in the car. He stated the driver remained in the car and appeared to be fumbling around in the car attempting to find something. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Russell if he saw anyone approach the vehicle and talk with the driver. He stated no one approached the car while he was still on the scene of the collision. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Russell if he could remember the approximate time he stopped at the collision scene. Mr. Russell stated he left the scene at approximately 7:49 a.m., and he thought he was on scene five to seven minutes before leaving. Mr. Russell stated he left the collision scene and continued to his doctor's appointment. A copy of this interview is included in this case file.

On Tuesday, April 12, 2016 TFC3 Hardy contacted the Vidalia Police Department. At the police department was Mr. Stephen C. Gordon, a witness to the collision on State Route 292. Mr. Gordon consented to a phone interview, which was recorded by the Vidalia Police Department. Mr. Gordon read a written statement he had prepared. After reading the statement TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Gordon who he saw approaching the scene of the collision. Mr. Gordon said he saw two women, the male driver of the vehicle involved in the collision and two other males approach the victim. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Gordon if he observed the sedan that struck the bicyclist cross over the white fog line. Mr. Gordon stated he noticed the debris coming over the vehicle and it appeared to him that the sedan was traveling to the right side of the travel lane. He stated he could not say the vehicle was on the shoulder at the time of the collision. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Gordon if he saw the bicyclist prior to the collision. Mr. Gordon stated he did not see the bicyclist. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Gordon if he recognized the driver of the sedan that hit the cyclist. He stated he only knew the driver appeared to have red hair and appeared to be a short white male looking back in the rearview mirror. A copy of this audio recorded interview and the written statement are included in this case file.

On Wednesday, April 13, 2016, Cpl. Derrell Thigpen #773, S/Tpr. Brock Scott, TFC3 Michael Jackson #949, and TFC3 Charles Hardy #700 (SCRTF) traveled to the collision scene in order to perform a forensic map of the scene. The forensic map is used to record roadway characteristics, final rest of the vehicle, and any gouges, tire marks or furrows left by the vehicle. The forensic map was made by using the Leica Total Station. The Total Station is a measuring instrument that measures distances and angles to record information necessary to produce scaled diagrams of the entire collision scene. The scaled diagrams are referred to throughout the investigation. Cpl. Thigpen performed the setup of the Total Station and entered the shot codes while

communicating with TFC3 Hardy and TFC3 Jackson. All diagrams created from the mapping are included in the case file.

While still on the collision scene TFC3 Hardy noticed that State Route 292 west is a two lane state maintained roadway. The roadway has two solid yellow center lines with solid white fog lines painted on the edges. Between the fog line and the grass shoulder is a paved strip of asphalt that is approximately 2 feet in width. The shoulder of the roadway is unpaved and grass. The roadway is asphalt paved with no apparent defects. On this section of roadway the traffic is traveling straight in a 55 mile per hour zone with the lanes traveling in an east and west direction. The weather at the time of the collision was reported as clear skies with a temperature of 50 degrees and no precipitation reported on the roadway.

After completing the forensic mapping, Cpl. Thigpen, S/Tpr Scott, and TFC3 Jackson traveled to Cooper's Towing in Vidalia. The purpose of the trip was to perform and inspection of the silver 2010 Lincoln MKZ and the Fuji bicycle. The 2010 Lincoln was displaying a Georgia tag number PGK9725 with a VIN: 3LNHL2GC6AR641091. There was damage to the right front bumper, grill, hood, windshield, and the roof. The damage was indicative of the vehicle striking a person riding a bicycle. No mechanical defects were found that would have contributed to this collision. The green and orange Fuji bicycle was also inspected. The rear tire damage was indicative of being struck in the rear by a vehicle traveling in the same direction as the bicycle. No mechanical defects were found that would have contributed to this collision. While still at the towing yard the silver 2010 Lincoln MKZ was weighted using a set of State of Georgia certified Haenni model WL101 portable scales. The weight of the car as it sat on the scales was 3,750 lbs. The scales were provided by MCO2 Justin Sumner of the Motor Carrier Compliance Division Region 7. The complete results of these inspections are included in this report.

On Thursday, April 14, 2016, TFC3 Hardy traveled back to Vidalia to attempt to locate any other witnesses to the collision on Monday, April, 11, 2016. No other persons were located that stated they actually saw the collision.

On Tuesday, April 19, 2016 TFC3 Hardy traveled to 404 Durden Street in Vidalia. At the above address TFC3 Hardy contacted Attorney Daniel B. Snipes and his client, Attorney Michael Blake Tillery to perform an audio recorded interview. Mr. Tillery and Mr. Snipes agreed to the interview prior to my arrival. Mr. Tillery stated on the Sunday night prior to the collision he had just returned from his honeymoon. He stated he dropped his wife off in Athens. He stated he then returned to Vidalia around 11:00 a.m. He further added the he went to bed around 1:00 a.m. and awoke at approximately 6:00 a.m. He stated this was his normal time to awake lately since he was involved in a campaign. He stated he was at Chatters restaurant at or before 7:00 a.m. to visit with the farmer's before going to his office. Mr. Tillery stated he ate breakfast with several men to include Senator Tommie Williams. TFC3 Hardy ask Mr. Tillery approximately what time he left Chatter's. Mr. Tillery stated he left at approximately 7:40 a.m. and headed to his office for a Monday morning meeting. TFC3

Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if this was his normal route back to his office. Mr. Tillery stated he usually went back into Lyons, to the Toombs County Courthouse. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he noticed the gentlemen on the bicycle pass by while he was sitting at Chatters. Mr. Tillery stated he did not see the gentlemen on the bicycle pass by Chatters. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery which driveway or street he used to exit Chatter's and enter onto State Route 292. Mr. Tillery stated he exited the Chatter's parking lot and entered the road between Chatter's and the Toombs County Health Department (Moore Circle). TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he entered State Route 292 behind a vehicle. Mr. Tillery stated he did get behind a vehicle and it was a loaded log truck. Mr. Tillery stated he caught up to the log truck near Semco Drive, because cars ahead of the log truck were turning onto Semco Drive. Mr. Tillery stated he remembered the shadows of a large tree on the highway just ahead of the log truck and thinking how clear the skies were at that time of the day. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he noticed the log truck swerve or move either direction while traveling westbound on State Route 292. Mr. Tillery stated he didn't notice the truck move, but he did remember the traffic passing them in the opposite direction. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he was using his phone for any reason while following the log truck. He stated he was not using his phone while driving. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery what he was doing just prior to the collision. Mr. Tillery stated he was watching the log truck in front of him and he noticed a blue car approaching from the opposite direction that moved to the right. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if the GPS and radio were on prior to the collision. Mr. Tillery stated both stay on all of the time. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery what he remembered after the collision happened. Mr. Tillery stated he remembered coming out of the shadows of the trees and it appeared to him the bicyclist was attempting to get or move away from him. He then added he remembered he heard the sound and hoping it was anything other than what it was. He then heard the sound of his bumper dragging the ground and then trying to pull the car to the side of the road. He stated he then noticed a purple car fly by and not stop. He then ran back to check on the bicyclist. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he called 911. He stated a lady on scene had already called within seconds of the collision. He stated by the time he ran to the bicyclist other vehicles were stopping on the shoulder. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he remembered how fast he was traveling at the time of the collision. He stated he was traveling with the flow of traffic traveling westbound. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if any of the people talked to him on scene. He stated he was approached while he was kneeling down near the bicyclist. He stated a gentleman checked the bicyclist for a pulse, but after checking twice he was unable to feel a pulse. He stated the lady he saw on the cell phone also stated she saw the collision. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he could remember how the bicyclist was laying after the collision. Mr. Tillery stated the bicyclist was lying on his right side wearing darker clothing, with a boomer bag on his back. He stated he remembered seeing the wedding ring on the bicyclist's finger and knowing it was a male. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery at what point did he get up and go back to his car. Mr. Tillery stated Teresa Meadows McClain pulled him back from the bicyclist and they talked for a short time. He stated by this time several people had arrived on scene. He stated he felt he was there alone, but he knew he wasn't alone at the scene. TFC3 Hardy asked if anyone took him back to his car, or did he go to the car alone. Mr. Tillery stated Ms. McClain pulled him back some, but

eventually Ms. McClain told him he needed to call his wife. Mr. Tillery stated he told Ms. McClain that he needed to call his office, because he was supposed to be at the office for a meeting at 8:00 a.m. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he remembered talking to any of the responding law enforcement. He stated he remembered seeing the EMS personnel first and he didn't talk to the EMS personnel at all. He stated he did talk to a Vidalia officer, but he does not remember his name. He stated he remembers hearing the Vidalia officer's state they needed to contact the Georgia State Patrol to work the collision. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he left the scene before the Georgia State Patrol arrived. He stated he did not leave the scene for any reason. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Tillery if he remembered anything else about the collision that he may have not been asked about during the interview. Mr. Tillery stated he hadn't thought about it much until the interview, but he remembered the shadows from the trees as he approached the collision scene. He stated he remembers being in the shadows of the trees at impact. TFC3 Hardy asked him if he was wearing his seat belt at the time of the collision. Mr. stated he was wearing the seat belt at the time of the collision. TFC3 Hardy also asked Mr. Tillery if the bicyclist had on the backpack after the collision. Mr. Tillery stated the backpack was on the bicyclist after the collision and that the EMS personnel cut the pack off before transport. A copy of this interview is included in this case file.

On Thursday, April 21, 2016, TFC3 Hardy traveled to Lyons to make contact with Middle Judicial Circuit Chief Investigator Allen W. McCall. The purpose of the trip was to receive assistance writing a search warrant for Michael Blake Tillery's cell phone. The search warrant was written and Chief McCall sent the warrant to the attorneys in the Middle Judicial Circuits office for approval.

While still in Lyons, TFC3 Hardy traveled to the Allcare Pharmacy located at 112 Oxley Drive in Lyons. At the pharmacy TFC3 Hardy requested the video from the camera system installed on the outside of the pharmacy. Using rear camera number 5 a white or silver car is visible parked in front of Chatters restaurant. At 7:41:27 a.m. a white male is seen entering the car on the driver's side and backing from the parking space. At 7:42:10 a.m. a log truck enters the frame and at 7:42:22 a.m. the white or silver car leaves the road (Moore Circle) next to the Chatters parking lot pulling in behind the log truck. From 7:42:22 a.m. until the initial Toombs County 911 call of 7:43:50 a.m., is 1 minute and 28 seconds. Taking this route from Moore Circle at the stop sign and turning right, traveling to the collision scene in a vehicle without traffic, takes 1 minute and 19 seconds. A copy of this video is included in this case file.

On Friday, April 22, 2016, TFC3 Hardy with warrant in hand traveled to the Emanuel County Courthouse to make contact with Chief Superior Court Judge, Kathy S. Palmer. Judge Palmer reviewed the warrant and signed the warrant. Judge Palmer assigned J. Stanley Smith, an attorney from Dublin, to act as special master. Mr. Smith would accompany the troopers to Mr. Tillery's place of business.

After leaving Judge Palmer's office TFC3 Hardy made contact with J. Stanley Smith by phone. Mr. Smith stated he would let TFC3 Hardy know when they could travel to Mr. Tillery's office in Vidalia to serve the search warrant for the phone.

Also on April 22, 2016, TFC3 Hardy received Mr. Tillery's Verizon phone records from Chief Investigator McCall. The phone records indicated two text messages were sent from the phone at 7:43 a.m. on the morning of the collision. One message was sent at 7:43 a.m. and delivered at the same time. The second message was sent at 7:43 a.m. and delivered at 7:44 a.m. Prior to the collision a phone call was made at 7:34 a.m., but the next phone call was made at 7:56 a.m. after the collision.

On Tuesday April 26, 2016, TFC3 Hardy and Attorney J. Stanley Smith traveled to 404 Durden Street in Vidalia. This is the Law Office of Michael Blake Tillery. TFC3 Hardy and Mr. Smith made contact with Mr. Tillery at the office. It was explained to Mr. Tillery the reason for the visit. Mr. Tillery was informed of the search warrant. Mr. Tillery stated he was just returning from the local Verizon store, where he purchased a new phone. He stated the original phone from the search warrant was in his car in the box the new phone came in. TFC3 Hardy and Mr. Tillery walked outside to his parked car to retrieve the phone. Mr. Tillery removed the phone from his car and handed it to TFC3 Hardy. TFC3 Hardy removed the phone from the box and placed it in a faraday bag. TFC3 Hardy placed the faraday bag into an evidence bag and sealed it after going back into Mr. Tillery's office. TFC3 Hardy sealed and labeled the evidence bag and released it to J. Stanley Smith. A copy of the evidence sheet was left with Mr. Tillery. TFC3 Hardy and Mr. Smith left 404 Durden Street in Vidalia and traveled to 205 North Franklin Street in Dublin. This is the Law Office of J. Stanley Smith. Mr. Smith placed the evidence into a gun safe located in his office. A copy of the search warrant is included in this case file.

On Wednesday, April 27, 2016, TFC3 Hardy traveled to Lyons to pick up the video from the Parkers conveniences store located at State Route 292 and Oxley Drive. Video was also retrieved from the camera at Southern Performance located at 104 Oxley Drive in Lyons. The Parkers video shows the bicyclist entering the frame of the camera at 7:35:07 a.m. and leaving the camera at 7:36:05 a.m. The same camera is also showing the log truck enter the frame at 7:41:24 a.m. and leave the camera frame at 7:41:36 a.m. Mr. Tillery pulled out behind the log truck shortly after this time. The camera from Southern Performance shows the bicyclist enter the frame at 6:35:07 a.m. and leave the camera frame at 6:35:35 a.m. The bicyclist is seen riding between the white fog line and the grass shoulder. Also the camera times are one hour different because the camera time wasn't reset to daylight savings time. The same camera is showing the log truck enter the frame at 6:41:19 a.m. and leave the frame at 6:41:31 a.m., with Mr. Tillery pulling out behind the log truck shortly thereafter. Toombs County 911 received the first call at 7:43:50 a.m. Using the Parkers video camera time of 7:41:36 a.m. (Log Truck Leaving Frame) and using the Toombs 911 initial call time of 7:43:50 a.m., there is 2 minutes and 14 seconds in-between the two. Using the Southern Performance camera time of 6:41:31 a.m. (Log Truck Leaving Frame) and

using the Toombs County 911 initial call time of 7:43:50 a.m., there is 2 minutes and 19 seconds in-between the two. A copy of these videos are included in this case file.

On Wednesday, April 27, 2016 a report was generated by the Division of Forensic Sciences, of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation Crime Lab. The report was for the blood alcohol analysis of Michael Blake Tillery obtained under voluntary consent. The results indicated Mr. Tillery was not under the influence of alcohol at the time of the collision. A copy of this report is included in this case file.

On Thursday, April 28, 2016, TFC3 Hardy traveled to Summertown, GA in Emanuel County. In Summertown, TFC3 Hardy meets with Gerald Harrison, the driver of the log truck (Wood Masters) seen in the video cameras in Lyons. Mr. Harrison stated he was coming from Mark Collins shop in Cobbtown, GA. Mr. Harrison stated he left the shop in Cobbtown at approximately 7:10 a.m. on Monday, April 11, 2016 headed to Cox Industries Inc. He stated he came into Lyons on State Route 152 and turned right onto State Route 292. He stated he traveled State Route 292 from Lyons to Vidalia where he turned right from State Route 292 onto State Route 297. TFC3 Hardy asked Mr. Harrison if he remembered anyone walking or riding a bicycle as he traveled from Lyons into Vidalia. Mr. Harrison stated he did not remember seeing anyone and if he had seen someone, he would have remembered because, he would have moved over to pass them at some point. A copy of this audio recorded interview is included in this case file.

On Thursday, May 26, 2016 a report was generated by the Division of Forensic Sciences of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation. The report was on the blood toxicology analysis of Michael Blake Tillery obtained under voluntary consent. The results indicated Mr. Tillery was not under the influence of any illegal drugs at the time of the collision. The results did indicate Mr. Tillery had Dextromethorphan, which is a cough suppressant. The serious side effects Dextromethorphan are severe dizziness, anxiety, restless feeling, confusion, hallucinations or slow shallow breathing. The less serious side effects are upset stomach. A copy of this report is included in this case file.

On Wednesday, June 8, 2016 a report was generated by the Division of Forensic Sciences of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation. The report for the blood toxicology analysis of Bunji Mark Takaya, obtained postmortem. The results indicated Mr. Takaya was not under the influence of any drugs at the time of the collision. A copy of this report is included in this case file.

On Tuesday, June 21, 2016 a report was generated by the Division of Forensic Sciences of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation. The report was on the blood alcohol analysis of Bunji Mark Takaya, obtained postmortem. The results indicated Mr. Takaya was not under the influence of alcohol at the time of the collision. A copy of this report is included in this case file.

On Wednesday, July 6, 2016 a report was generated by the Division of Forensic Sciences of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation. The report was on the

Autopsy of Bunji Mark Takaya. The report indicated Mr. Takaya died of multiple injuries due to a bicyclist being struck by a vehicle. A copy of this report is included in this case file.

The evidence in this case will show that Michael Blake Tillery was operating a silver 2010 Lincoln MKZ, which was traveling westbound on State Route 292 on Monday, April 11, 2016, in Toombs County. Mr. Tillery failed to maintain his lane of travel (40-6-48), striking the rear of a bicycle ridden by, Bunji Mark Takaya. Mr. Tillery failed to pass the bicyclist at a safe distance (40-6-56) by allowing no less than three feet "Safe Distance". Mr. Tillery's actions caused the death of Bunji Mark Takaya (40-6-393). It is evident that Mr. Tillery's failure to maintain his lane of travel caused the death of Bunji Mark Takaya.

This summary has been a chronological account of how information and evidence was obtained throughout this investigation. This investigation was compiled by TFC3 Charles Hardy #700 of the Georgia State Patrol Specialized Collision Reconstruction Team Troop F.





The facts tending to establish the foregoing grounds for issuance a search warrant are as follows:

TITLE 17 REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

AFFIANT is a certified peace officer pursuant to Chapter 8 of Title 35 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, having met the certification requirements pursuant to O.C.G.A. Section 35-8-8, and the training requirements under O.C.G.A. Section 35-8-9 and O.C.G.A. Section 35-8-17(a). Affiant meets the requirements set forth in Title 17, Chapter 5, Article 2, to wit, O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-20(a), and is therefore a qualified applicant for the issuance of this search warrant.

SUMMARY OF APPLICABLE STATUTES

Affiant demonstrates there is probable cause for the search/seizure of the person or property (i.e., premises, vehicle, and/or electronic device) and that the authority and jurisdiction exists. O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-21 provides that upon a showing of probable cause “that a crime is being committed or has been committed and which particularly describes the place or person, or both, to be searched and things to be seized, any judicial officer authorized to hold a court of inquiry to examine into an arrest of an offender against the penal laws...may issue a search warrant for the seizure of... (a)(1) [a]ny instruments, articles, or things, including the private papers of any person, which are designed, intended for use, or which have been used in the commission of the offense...; (a)(2) [a]ny person who has been kidnapped in violation of the laws of this state, who has been kidnapped

in another jurisdiction and is now concealed within this state, or any human fetus or human corpse; (a)(3) [s]tolen or embezzled property; (a)(4) [a]ny item, substance, object, thing, or matter, the possession of which is unlawful; [and/or] (a)(5) [a]ny instruments, articles or things, any information or data, and anything that is tangible or intangible, corporeal or incorporeal, visible or invisible evidence of the commission of the crime for which probable cause is shown, other than the private papers of any person.”

Further, O.C.G.A. Section 17-2-1 states:

(a) It is the policy of this state to exercise its jurisdiction over crime and persons charged with the commission of crime to the fullest extent allowable under, and consistent with, the Constitution of this state and the Constitution of the United States.

(b) Pursuant to this policy, a person shall be subject to prosecution in this state for a crime which he commits, while either within or outside the state, by his own conduct or that of another for which he is legally accountable, if:

(1) The crime is committed either wholly or partly within the state; (2) The conduct outside the state constitutes an attempt to commit a crime within the state; or, (3) The conduct within the state constitutes an attempt to commit in another jurisdiction a crime under the laws of both this state and the other jurisdiction.

(c) A crime is committed partly within this state if either the conduct which is an element of the crime or the result which is such an element occurs within the state. In homicide, the "result" is either the act which causes death or the death itself; and, if the body of a homicide victim is found within this state, the death is presumed to have occurred within the state.

(d) A crime which is based on an omission to perform a duty imposed by the law of this state is committed within the state, regardless of the location of the accused at the time of the omission.

In addition to having probable cause and jurisdiction, your affiant acknowledges the execution of any warrant issued by this Court must be done within a limited time. O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-25 requires, “[t]he search warrant shall be executed within ten (10) days from the time of issuance.... Any search not executed within ten (10) days from the time of issuance shall be void and shall be returned to the court of the judicial officer issuing the same as “not executed.”

O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-27 provides “All necessary and reasonable force may be used to effect and entry into any building or property or part thereof to execute a search warrant is, after verbal notice or an attempt in good faith to give verbal notice by the officer directed to execute the same of his authority and purpose—he is refused admittance—the person or persons within the building or property or part thereof refuse to acknowledge and answer the verbal notice or the presence of the person or persons therein is unknown to the officer—the building or property or part thereof is not then occupied by any person.”

Additionally, O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-28 allows “in the execution of the search warrant the officer executing the same may reasonably detain or search any person in the place at the time...to prevent the disposal or concealment of any instruments, articles, or things particularly described in the search warrant.”

O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-32 makes the following provisions:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no search and seizure without a warrant shall be conducted and no search warrant shall be issued for any documentary evidence in the possession of an attorney who is not a criminal suspect, unless the application for the search warrant specifies that the place to be searched is in the possession or custody of an attorney and also shows that there is probable cause to believe that the documentary evidence will be destroyed or secreted in the event a search warrant is not issued. **This Code section shall not impair the ability to serve search warrants in cases in which the search is directed against an attorney if there is probable cause to suspect such attorney has committed a crime.** This Code section shall not impair the ability to serve subpoenas on non-suspect attorneys.

In any case in which there is probable cause to believe that documentary evidence will be destroyed or secreted if a search warrant is not issued, no search warrant shall be issued or be executed for any documentary evidence in the possession or custody of an attorney **who is not a criminal suspect** unless:

At the time the warrant is issued the court shall appoint a special master to accompany the person who will serve the warrant. The special master shall be an attorney who is a member in good standing of the State Bar of Georgia and who has been selected from a list of qualified attorneys maintained by the State Bar of Georgia. **Upon service of the warrant, the special master shall inform the party served of the specific items being sought and that the party shall have the opportunity to provide the items requested.** If the party, in the judgment of the special master, fails to provide the items requested, the special master shall conduct a search for the items in the areas indicated in the search warrant;

If the party who has been served states that an item or items should not be disclosed, such item or items shall be sealed by the special master and taken to the superior court for a hearing. At the hearing the party whose premises has been searched shall be entitled to raise any issues which may be raised pursuant to *Code Section 17-5-30* as well as claims that the item or items are privileged or claims that the item or items are inadmissible because they were obtained in violation of this Code section. Any such hearing shall be held in the superior court;

Any such warrant must, whenever practicable, be served during normal business hours. The law enforcement officer or prosecutor serving the warrant shall not participate in the search but may accompany the special master when the special master is conducting the search;

Any such warrant must be served upon a party who appears to have possession or control of the items sought. If, after reasonable efforts, the party serving the warrant is unable to locate any such person, the special master shall seal and return to the court for determination by the court any items which appear to be privileged;

Any such warrant shall be issued only by the superior court. At the time of applying for such a warrant, the law enforcement officer or prosecutor shall submit a written search plan designed to minimize the intrusiveness of the search. **When the warrant is executed, the special master carrying out the search shall have a duty to make reasonable efforts to minimize the intrusiveness of the search.**

In the event electronic storage devices, that is, cell phones, smartphone, tablets, laptops, etc. are included in the items to be seized, then, your affiant states that this provision does not require the government to obtain a second warrant to conduct a search (i.e., "full forensic search" of) electronic devices such as computers, tablets, cellphones, or smartphones, where sufficient probable cause existed within the first warrant, just because the forensic extraction was not initiated within the ten (10) day period as long as the devices were lawfully seized under the warrant. In support of this proposition, your Affiant reminds that in Mastrogiovanni v. State, 324 Ga. App. 739 (2013), the Georgia Court of Appeals affirmed the lower court's decision in this regard. In fact, the Court further opined, "We are aware of no authority for the proposition that items seized from the lawful execution of a search warrant must then be analyzed, tested, or examined within the ten-day period provided for in O.C.G.A. 17-5-25. The State analogizes the forensic analysis of Mastrogiovanni's computer to the chemical analysis of substances that field-tested positive for illegal drugs when seized pursuant to a search warrant. The State is not required to obtain a second warrant to analyze the substance or, for example, conduct ballistic tests on seized firearms" (324 Ga. App. at 743). This logic is, therefore, transferable to all electronic devices under similar circumstances, that is, devices that are seized upon facts that articulate sufficient probable cause.

PARTICULARIZED FACTS IN SUPPORT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

Your Affiant is employed by the Georgia State Patrol and further assigned to the Special Collision Reconstruction Team (SCRT) and investigates serious motor vehicle collisions and related fatalities. Further, your Affiant is sworn and a certified Georgia peace officer and as such is qualified to act as affiant in consideration for the issuance of this search warrant. Your Affiant provides the following particularized facts in this affidavit.

Affiant states on Monday, April 11, 2016, he was dispatched to Toombs County, Georgia to investigate a fatality involving a motor vehicle and a bicyclist on Georgia State Route 292 within the city of Vidalia. Your Affiant further identified the driver of the motor vehicle as Michael Blake Tillery (W/M, DOB 10/09/1983, SSN 252-49-5930), a licensed driver, and the decedent bicyclist as Bunji Mark Takaya (I/M, DOB 06/06/1971, FL OLN T-200-073-71-206-0). The collision scene

was photographed and marked for further investigation. Other law enforcement officers were present at the scene and relayed witness accounts and the spontaneous utterances of Michael Blake Tillery (hereafter "Tillery").

Your Affiant reports that another Georgia State Patrol trooper indicated that Tillery offered to submit to a blood alcohol test (BAT) presumably to demonstrate that he (Tillery) was not under the influence of an intoxicating beverage or a controlled substance that would impair his ability to operate a motor vehicle safely. However, Tillery did not offer to surrender his cellular telephone device or consent to a cursory examination of the device while at the collision scene. Affiant states to his knowledge Tillery left the collision scene with his cellular telephone device.

Affiant states the initial investigation reveals Tillery was operating a white in color 2010 Lincoln MKZ and was traveling in the westbound traffic lane on Georgia State Route 292 on the morning of April 11, 2016. Your Affiant further states Bunji Mark Takaya (hereafter "decedent") was traveling westbound on Georgia State Route 292 and was ahead of Tillery in the traffic lane and riding on a green and gold in color bicycle. Affiant states the evidence indicates that Tillery struck the decedent's bicycle in the rear while the decedent was riding between the painted white in color outside fog line and the grass shoulder. This suggests Tillery failed to maintain his motor vehicle within his lane of travel.

Your Affiant states Georgia State Route 292 is a two lane state maintained highway with painted solid yellow in color center line for the westbound traffic and painted white in color solid outside fog line. Affiant further states the eastbound traffic lanes have broken yellow in color painted lines and a solid white in color painted outside fog line. Affiant states the roadway is asphalt with no obvious defects and is straight and level on this portion of the roadway. Affiant further states the shoulder of the roadway is grass with no trees or bushes near the roadway travel lanes that would obstruct the view of the cyclist or other motorists traveling this portion of Georgia State Route 292. Your Affiant states at the time of the collision the sun was rising at the backs of the westbound traffic and, therefore, would not have been a factor in the collision. This suggests Tillery was following too close to the motor vehicle immediately in front of his vehicle.

Affiant states that it is a violation of law for a motorist to operate a motor vehicle while writing, sending, or reading text based communication (O.C.G.A. Section 40-6-241.2). Furthermore, the Georgia Code Annotated provides a definition for the term wireless telecommunications device. "As used in this Code section, the term "wireless telecommunications device" means a cellular telephone, a text messaging device, a personal digital assistant, a stand-alone computer, or any other substantially similar wireless device that is used to initiate or receive a wireless communication with another person. It does not include citizens band radios, citizens band radio hybrids, commercial two-way radio communication devices, subscription based emergency communications, in-vehicle security, navigation devices, and remote diagnostics systems, or amateur or ham radio devices." See O.C.G.A. Section 40-6-241.2(a). Additionally, sub-section (b)(1) provides "no person who is 18 years of age or older or who has a Class C license shall

operate a motor vehicle on any public road or highway of this state while using a wireless telecommunications device to write, send, or read any text based communication, including but not limited to a text message, instant message, e-mail, or Internet data.” Finally, sub-section (d) reads: “Any violation of this Code section shall constitute a separate offense.”

Your Affiant states distracted driving is inherently reckless and dangerous for both the safety of the driver and his passengers as well as other motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists. The Georgia Code Annotated provides that any person who drives any vehicle in reckless disregard for the safety of persons or property commits the offense of reckless driving. See O.C.G.A. Section 40-6-390. Affiant further states, “Any person who, **without malice aforethought**, causes the death of another person through the violation of subsection (a) of *Code Section 40-6-163*, **Code Section 40-6-390** or 40-6-391, or subsection (a) of *Code Section 40-6-395* **commits the offense of homicide by vehicle in the first degree** and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than three years nor more than 15 years.” See O.C.G.A. Section 40-6-393.

Affiant states in the process of his investigation he has inquired about collecting the cellular telephone belonging to Tillery and in his possession on the date and the time of the fatal collision. Additionally, your Affiant is aware that family of the decedent have filed a civil action in connection with the homicide of Bunji Mark Takaya. Affiant points to this observation in the public domain to further explain and acknowledge an order directing the device to be surrendered in an attempt to protect the loss of evidence in the pending civil action. However, as of Thursday, April 21, 2016, the device has not been surrendered and remains in the possession of Tillery.

Affiant states a preservation request was sent to Cellco Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless on Monday, April 11, 2016, to preserve existing non-content and content-based records relating to Verizon Wireless exchange 912-245-9915. Your Affiant further states a grand jury subpoena was sent to Cellco Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless, on Thursday, April 14, 2016, for the non-content based records for Verizon Wireless exchange 912-245-9915 and those records were received on Monday, April 18, 2016. A review of those records indicate the Verizon Wireless exchange 912-245-9915 belongs to Blake M. Tillery, 404 Durden Street, Vidalia, GA 30474, and a secondary telephone number of 912-537-3030. Additionally, the text message detail list indicates two text messages at the approximate time of the fatal collision.

Your Affiant states the circumstances surrounding the involuntary seizure of the Tillery device is complicated by his profession. Affiant states that the person Blake Tillery is known to him as an attorney at law with a law office located at 404 Durden Street, Vidalia (Toombs County), Georgia, that is, Smith & Tillery, PC. Your Affiant acknowledges that current devices have the ability to search the Internet, engage in social media applications, record and store audio, video, and digital images, and store files and data. The capacity of current devices is further expanded by cloud services making the extent of the information accessible from a device massive. However, some communications and transactions may be privileged and as such are protected. Therefore, the

seizure of the Tillery device should be contemplated within the understanding of O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-32. This does not mean that its seizure is unauthorized by law but instead that a deliberate process should be followed.

Affiant states that communications between parties that contemplate or discuss the destruction of evidence or the creation of testimony that is designed to avoid detection or the consequences of committing a criminal offense are not protected under the law. Depending on their content could further constitute additional violations of law that include criminal solicitation, party to a crime, conspiracy to commit a crime, and criminal attempt to commit crimes. In this instant consideration those crimes could include the destruction or tampering with evidence, the subordination of perjury or the making of false statements regarding material facts in a criminal investigation. However, the act of listing crimes should not be thought of as either an inference or as exhaustive.

Affiant proposes the following written plan of action.

Your Affiant requests the Court to appoint a special master to accompany this or another legally authorized officer to execute this warrant. Further, that the officer announces in the presence of the appointed special master that a seizure warrant exists and that Tillery surrender the device without manipulation of the device and that the device be placed in a special container (e.g., faraday bag) to further prevent evidence/data destruction from a remote means or access. Next that the device be appropriately labeled as evidence in the current case under investigation and placed in the custody of the special master until such time that the device can be accessed either voluntarily or by the authority of another warrant to search and seize the data contained with the device subject to the provisions of the warrant.

PRAYER OF AFFIANT

Affiant shows that, based upon the above and forgoing facts and information, he has probable cause to believe that the aforesaid property, to wit: contraband; stolen and/or embezzled property; evidence of crime(s) committed that constitutes a criminal violation of law pursuant to the Official Code of Georgia Annotated and, therefore, are subject to search and seizure pursuant to O.C.G.A. Section 17-5-21.

Affiant respectfully submits this affidavit so that a search may issue allowing affiant and other peace officers to enter the locations (i.e., premises, vehicle, electronic devices) above described and to search said person(s) and/or locations, accompanied by a special master appointed by the court, to seize and secure the Tillery electronic cellular device and place the device in the custody of the special master until such time that a separate warrant issues to forensically examine the contents of the device under the supervision of the special master and further direction of the court.

Moreover, affiant provides and further makes this affidavit so that a search warrant may issue for the search and seizure of the items aforesaid in a manner that follows the intent of the Georgia Code Annotated with respect to the search and/or seizure of documents (as defined in O.C.G.A.

Section 17-5-32) of the items seized pursuant to Article 2 of Chapter 5 of Title 17 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.







Do not use any other over-the-counter cough, cold, or allergy medication without first asking your doctor or pharmacist. If you take certain products together you may accidentally take too much of one or more types of medicine. Read the label of any other medicine you are using to see if it contains dextromethorphan.

Dextromethorphan will not treat a cough that is caused by smoking, asthma, or emphysema.


Before taking this medicine

Do not use dextromethorphan if you have used an MAO inhibitor such as isocarboxazid (Marplan), phenelzine (Nardil), rasagiline (Azilect), selegiline (Eldepryl, Emsam), or tranylcypromine (Parnate) within the past 14 days. Serious, life-threatening side effects can occur if you take dextromethorphan before the MAO inhibitor has cleared from your body.

Ask a doctor or pharmacist about using dextromethorphan if you have emphysema or chronic bronchitis.


Dextromethorphan may be harmful to an unborn baby. Tell your doctor if you are pregnant or plan to become pregnant during treatment. Dextromethorphan may pass into breast milk and could harm a nursing baby. Do not use this medication without telling your doctor if you are breast-feeding a baby.

Artificially-sweetened liquid forms of cough medicine may contain phenylalanine. This would be important to know if you have phenylketonuria (PKU). Check the ingredients and warnings on the medication label if you are concerned about phenylalanine.

How should I take dextromethorphan?

Use dextromethorphan exactly as directed on the label, or as it has been prescribed by your doctor. Do not use the medication in larger amounts, or use it for longer than recommended. Cough medicine is usually taken only for a short time until your symptoms clear up.

Do not give dextromethorphan to a child younger than 4 years old.

Always ask a doctor before giving cough or cold medicine to a child. Death can occur from the misuse of cough or cold medicine in very young children.

Measure the liquid form of dextromethorphan with a special dose-measuring spoon or cup, not a regular table spoon. If you do not have a dose-measuring device, ask your pharmacist for one.

Allow the dextromethorphan lozenge or disintegrating strip to dissolve in your mouth.

Drink extra fluids to help loosen the congestion and lubricate your throat while you are taking this medication. Talk with your doctor if your symptoms do not improve after 7 days of treatment, or if you have a fever with a headache, cough, or skin rash.

If you need to have any type of surgery, tell the surgeon ahead of time if you have taken a cough medicine within the past few days.

Store dextromethorphan at room temperature, away from heat, light, and moisture.

What happens if I miss a dose?

Since cough medicine is usually taken only as needed, you may not be on a dosing schedule. If you are taking the medication regularly, take the missed dose as soon as you remember. If it is almost time for your next dose, skip the missed dose and take the medicine at your next regularly scheduled time. Do not take extra medicine to make up the missed dose.

What happens if I overdose?

Seek emergency medical attention if you think you have used too much of this medicine.

Overdose symptoms may include feeling restless or nervous

What should I avoid?

Avoid drinking alcohol. It can increase some of the side effects of dextromethorphan. This medication can cause side effects that may impair your thinking or reactions. Be careful if you drive or do anything that requires you to be awake and alert.

Avoid taking diet pills, caffeine pills, or other stimulants (such as ADHD medications) without your doctor's advice. Taking a stimulant together with cough medicine can increase your risk of unpleasant side effects.

Do not use any other over-the-counter cough, cold, or allergy medication without first asking your doctor or pharmacist. Dextromethorphan is contained in many combination medicines available over the counter. If you take certain products together you may accidentally take too much of this medicine. Read the label of any other medicine you are using to see if it contains dextromethorphan.



Dextromethorphan side effects

Get emergency medical help if you have any of these signs of an allergic reaction: hives; difficulty breathing; swelling of your face, lips, tongue, or throat. Stop using dextromethorphan and call your doctor at once if you have any of these serious side effects:

- severe dizziness, anxiety, restless feeling, or nervousness;
- confusion, hallucinations; or
- slow, shallow breathing.

Less serious side effects are more likely, such as stomach upset.

This is not a complete list of dextromethorphan side effects and others may occur. Call your doctor for medical advice about side effects. You may report side effects to FDA at 1-800-FDA-1088.

What other drugs will affect dextromethorphan?

Before taking dextromethorphan, tell your doctor if you are using any of the following drugs:

- celecoxib (Celebrex);
- cinacalcet (Sensipar);
- darifenacin (Enablex);
- imatinib (Gleevec);
- quinidine (Quinaglute, Quinidex);
- ranolazine (Ranexa)
- ritonavir (Norvir);
- sibutramine (Meridia);
- terbinafine (Lamisil);
- medicines to treat high blood pressure; or
- antidepressant medications such as amitriptyline (Elavil, Etrafon), bupropion (Wellbutrin, Zyban), fluoxetine (Prozac, Sarafem), fluvoxamine (Luvox), imipramine (Janimine, Tofranil), paroxetine (Paxil), sertraline (Zoloft), and others.

This list is not complete and there may be other drugs that can interact with dextromethorphan. Tell your doctor about all the prescription and over-the-counter medications you use. This includes vitamins, minerals, herbal products, and drugs prescribed by other doctors. Do not start using a new medication without telling your doctor


