COUNTS 1 through 10: In the name and on behalf of the citizens of the State of Georgia, do hereby charge and accuse **SHERRY WALDROP** with the offense of: **MEDICAID FRAUD a felony, in violation of O.C.G.A. § 49-4-146.1 (b) (1)** in that the said accused in the State and County aforesaid between on or about November 30, 2023 and continuing through April 15, 2024, did unlawfully obtain, attempt to obtain, and retain for herself payments from Georgia Medicaid to which the accused was not entitled and in amounts greater than that to which she was entitled, by engaging in a fraudulent scheme, to wit:

1.

Individuals who receive services provided by Medicaid are commonly referred to as “recipients” or “beneficiaries.”

2.

Georgia Medicaid, operated by and through the Georgia Department of Community Health, offers a program known as New Option Waiver Program (NOW) and Comprehensive Support Waiver Program (COMP), which allows eligible disabled and elderly individuals to receive services in their homes.

3.

Within NOW/COMP there is a program which allows the recipient to select a caregiver of their choice to provide personal support services to the recipient in the recipient’s home.

4.

The selected caregiver is paid for services provided to the recipient by reporting their times of service to Acumen Fiscal Agent, LLC (Acumen), a contractor with Georgia Medicaid that provides administrative and fiduciary services. Acumen uses money received from Georgia Medicaid to make payments to the caregiver.

5.

On or about May 1, 2015, Medicaid recipient D.C. began participating in the NOW/COMP program.

6.

On or about June 2, 2020, administrative documents were submitted to Acumen identifying SHERRY WALDROP as the caregiver selected to provide care for D.C.

7.

Acumen provided SHERRY WALDROP with a Money Network Bank paycard, account no. xxxx4903, card no. xxxx3645 which was designated to deposit payments for personal support services SHERRY WALDROP purportedly provided to D.C.

8.

On or about November 1, 2023, recipient D.C. notified Acumen of her cancellation of services, thereby terminating her participation in the NOW/COMP program.

9.

As part of her fraudulent scheme and device, SHERRY WALDROP continued to report times for service dates November 1, 2023, through February 8, 2024, for services purportedly provided to D.C. All such time entries were

false and fraudulent since SHERRY WALDROP did not provide the services reported.

10.

By submitting false reports SHERRY WALDROP caused Acumen to deposit payroll payments into the Money Network Bank paycard belonging to SHERRY WALDROP.

11.

As a result of SHERRY WALDROP's fraudulent scheme and device, the accused unlawfully obtained and retained payments to which she was not entitled, and in amounts greater than that to which she was entitled, on the dates and in the amounts identified as follows, each entry constituting a separate offense,
