
ORDER AND NOTICE

The above and foregoing verified Complaint having been read and considered, and the same having prayed for a temporary restraining order to be issued without notice to defendant, and having alleged that immediate and irreparable injury will result to the plaintiff if such a restraining order is not issued, and the attorney for plaintiff having certified as to his efforts to give such notice and as to reasons why such notice should not be required, and it appearing to the court that a proper case has been made out for a temporary restraining order, it is hereby ordered and adjudged:

- 1.) That temporary restraining order is hereby issued to Defendants **enjoining them** and **restraining them** from conducting any open burning of roots, limbs, tailings, or other debris on their property within the city limits of Glennville Georgia .
- 2.) That Defendants are so **enjoined** and **restrained** for a period of not to exceed 30 days after entry of this ORDER.
- 3.) That Plaintiff give security in the amount of \$ To BE DETERMINED AT THE HEARING for payment of costs and damages suffered by Defendants if they are found to have been wrongfully restrained.

4.) That the 6th day of May, 2025 at 9 AM is set down for the hearing on the interlocutory injunction at Evans County Courthouse as prayed for in the Complaint.
